

# Parking Options During Construction

Due to City Hall's construction on Marion Street, for several months Marion Street and our off-street parking lot will be closed. During this time, the City has provided several parking options including six reserved parking spaces along Christian Street and parking in either the Duke Street or Prince Street parking garages. If you have a disability or handicap and need special parking, please contact us at 291-1700.

## From North, East and West

From Route 30 take the Route 23 West (Walnut Street) exit into Lancaster. Cross Lime Street and then turn left onto Duke Street, staying in the right lane. Cross over Chestnut Street. On your right is the entrance to the Duke Street Parking Garage. To reach the six parking spaces closer to our office on Christian Street, immediately after the entrance to the Duke Street Parking Garage and right before the large Verizon sign, turn right. Continue on this one-way street and turn left at the corner. Ahead are six reserved and bagged meter spaces for GKH parking (although it says NO PARKING, you have permission to park there and you will not be ticketed). If these are occupied, proceed to Orange Street and turn right. Cross over Queen Street and enter the Prince Street Parking Garage on your right. A voucher to cover the cost of parking in either the Duke Street or Prince Street garages is available from GKH's receptionist. Enter our office at 41 East Orange Street.

## From South

Take Queen Street north into Lancaster. Cross Orange Street and then turn right onto Chestnut Street. Go one block and turn right onto Duke Street, staying in the right lane. On your right is the entrance to the Duke Street Parking Garage. To reach the six parking spaces closer to our office on Christian Street, immediately after the entrance to the Duke Street Parking Garage and right before the large Verizon sign, turn right. Continue on this one-way street and turn left at the corner. Ahead are six reserved and bagged meter spaces for GKH parking (although it says NO PARKING, you have permission to park there and you will not be ticketed). If these are occupied, proceed to Orange Street and turn right. Cross over Queen Street and enter the Prince Street Parking Garage on your right. A voucher to cover the cost of parking in either the Duke Street or Prince Street garages is available from GKH's receptionist. Enter our office at 41 East Orange Street.
